

General Practice in Aged Care Incentives Registration

The General Practice in Aged Care Incentive replaces the existing Aged Care Access Incentive from 1 July 2024.

Practices need to be registered in the Organisation Register, providers need to be linked to their MyMedicare-registered practice.

Register your practice

- 1. Select your Organisation Register
- 2. Select the Associated sites tab
- 3. Enter the ID number for the practice
- 4. Program Registration > MyMedicare GPACI.

Register for GPACI

- Log in to PRODA to access your HPOS account.
- Register for MyMedicare.
- Add practice bank account details.
- ADD GPACI registration.
- Add the Incentive indicator and link the Responsible Provider to your patient's Mymedicare profile

Add or update banking

- 1. Register for MyMedicare
- 2. Select the Action colum > Details
- 3. Select Banking details
- 4. Add
- 5. Wait 24 hours before GPACI is selectable in the next step.
