

Allergies and Reactions



When prescribing, Bp Premier will check the patient's recorded allergies and reactions and notify the provider with an alert if a drug class or ingredient may cause a reaction.

Add, Edit or Delete an Allergy



Select **Drug class** to be warned about all products in a class.

If you select **Ingredient**, **Specific product** or **Non drug**, only exact matches will generate a warning when prescribing.



Reactions recorded with the **Other** radio button, and free text typed in DON'T trigger a warning.

When prescribing medications, the information about them, including their interactions with other medications, is checked with the MIMS entry.

Bp Premier checks for:

- interactions with conditions recorded in the patient's history
- interactions with other medications the patient has been already prescribed.

Other Warning Factors

If the patient has been prescribed a medication they are allergic to:

1. Right-click the medication in the **Current Rx** tab.
2. Select **Cease Rx**.
3. Check the **Add to allergies/adverse reactions** checkbox.

Other conditions that will trigger the warning when prescribing medication:

- Pregnancy (1 – warning example)
- Breast feeding
- Elite Athlete ticked in the Family history tab (2)
