Record Immunisation

1. Choose 'Not given here' or 'Given Overseas' to record immunisation performed elsewhere.

If the patient is under eight years old, the relevant schedule will automatically be populated in patient record. This includes the Indigenous schedule.

Vaccinations that the patient is too young for will be disabled.



You will get an alert if the minimum details for a patient to be identified by the AIR have not been added to the patient demographic.

2. Untick to send to AIR later.
From the main screen, select **Utilities > Australian Immunisation Register > Send to AIR**.

Edit an immunisation:
Right-click the immunisation > **Edit** > make changes > tick **Update and Send to AIR** > **Save**.

Add a Non-listed Injection

Patient's **Today's notes > Procedure** from the row of buttons at the bottom.

1. If you cannot find the injection in the procedure list, free type it here.

Search for Immunisation

1. From the main screen, select **Utilities > Search**.
2. Click **Immunisations > Set report criteria > Ok**.
3. Click **Run query**.

Select the logical operators **AND**, **OR**, and **NOT** before adding a condition. Once added, the condition cannot be edited. Remove the condition by selecting it and pressing **Del** on your keyboard.
